THE ARCH.

Hidden underneath the South side of Putney Bridge is a custom constructed, sixty seat theatre, built into a flooding dock. You enter through the gardens of St Mary's Church. It has a cave feel to it. It's dark and can get quite cold or quite warm, depending on the outside temperature. In the gardens is a second venue, a pop up bar and box office and a listed church building. The space has two corded microphones and stands, a basic PA and lighting system. The seating in the venue is long wooden benches. You can move the seating but you'll be expected to leave the space as you find it. There are also listed parts of the church in the top corner behind the lighting bar, which cannot be moved or touched. Whilst the stage is 16' x 8', the actual playing space is about 10' x 8' due to the height of the Arch. This venue is the definition of a "pop up fringe space." Whilst it is our largest theatre, it is not for everyone.
